How to Change the Writing Point of Your Parker 45 Pen

Should you wish to change the style or the point becomes damaged, your Parker dealer can supply you with a new point assembly for a nominal cost. To remove old point, hold the point with absorbent tissue and turn counter-clockwise until the entire point assembly slips out. Insert new point and turn clockwise until the new point is seated firmly.

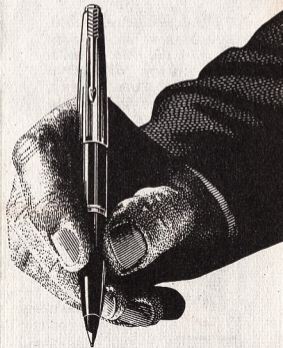
Long Term Care of Your Parker 45

Your Parker 45 will function better if it is flushed out thoroughly every six months. To clean the point and ink feed, immerse the point in the ink you use (preferably Parker Quink) for about five minutes. Another method is to unscrew the barrel and remove the ink cartridge or converter unit and let a slow stream of cold water pass through the pen. Shake out any excess water and let the point rest on absorbent tissue to draw out any excess water. Return cartridge or converter and after writing a few moments, the original ink color will return.

How to Load Your Parker 45 Mechanical Pencil

Turn the cap clockwise until a click is heard to make sure all old lead particles are ejected. Then turn the cap counter-clockwise until a slight resistance is felt. Insert new lead into tip. Turn cap clockwise until lead projects about 1/8". Press point on table top or pad of paper to seat new lead securely.

To Insert an Ink Cartridge



- 1 Unscrew barrel and insert new ink cartridge with the colored collar pointing forward as shown. Push in gently until you feel the cartridge seat itself.

- 2 Replace the barrel and the tightening motion will puncture the cartridge inside the pen. Your hands will be free of ink.



- 3 Touch the point to paper and allow a few moments for the ink to reach the pen point.



Parker Tap-Tank Ink Cartridges— A Reserve Ink Supply Always on Tap!

When you run out of ink, tap the cartridge smartly with your finger—watch the reserve ink supply flow down into the pen. Write up to 700 more words—enough to get you past any emergency.

To Fill Your Parker 45 From a Bottle



- 1 Remove the ink cartridge and insert the converter unit with the open end facing the pen point. Push in gently to assure proper seating.



- 2 Press the ribbed bar four times to get a maximum fill. Replace barrel and remove excess ink from point with soft tissue.
